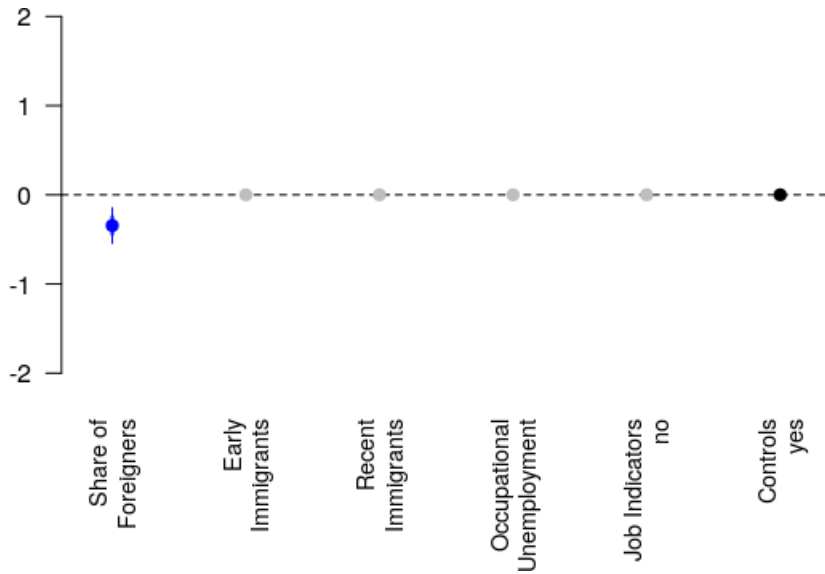

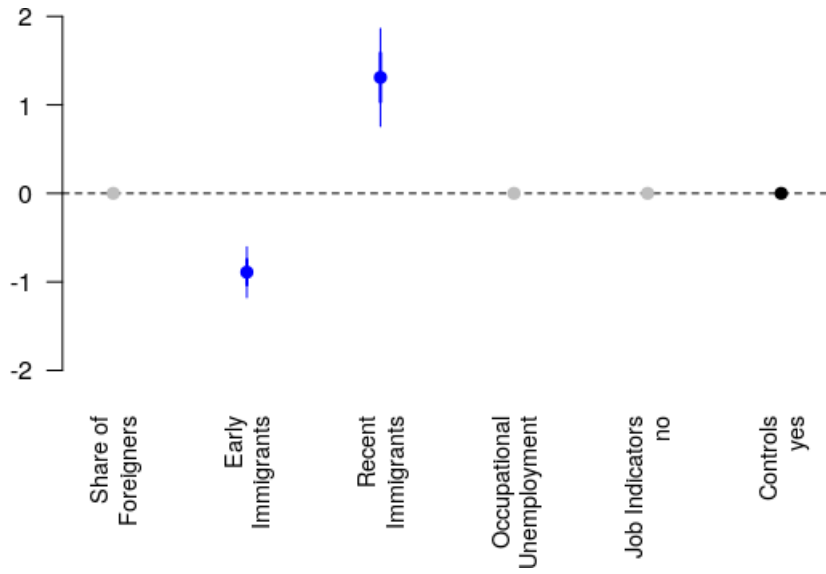

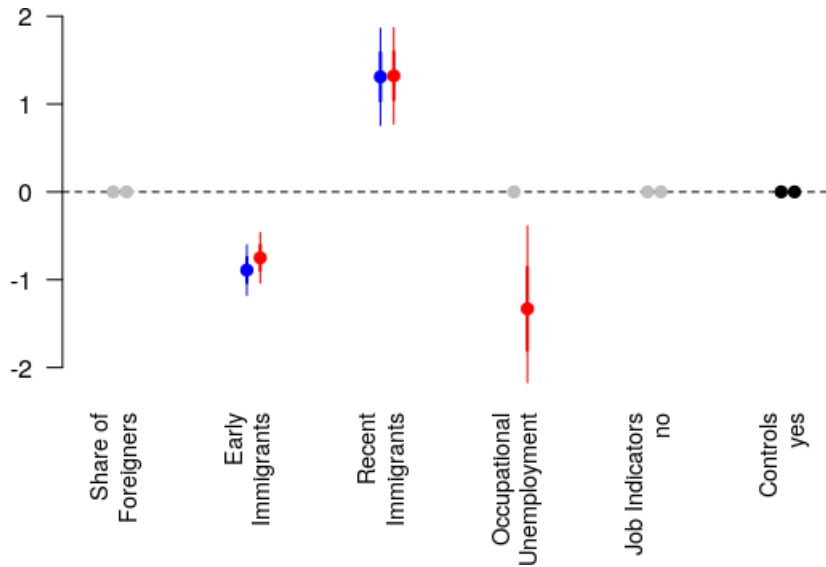
More foreigners = more negative



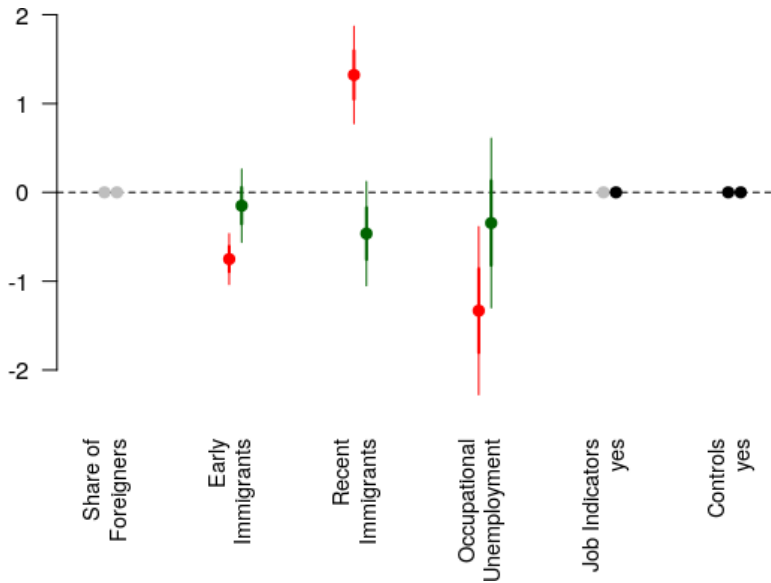
Recent foreigners = more positive



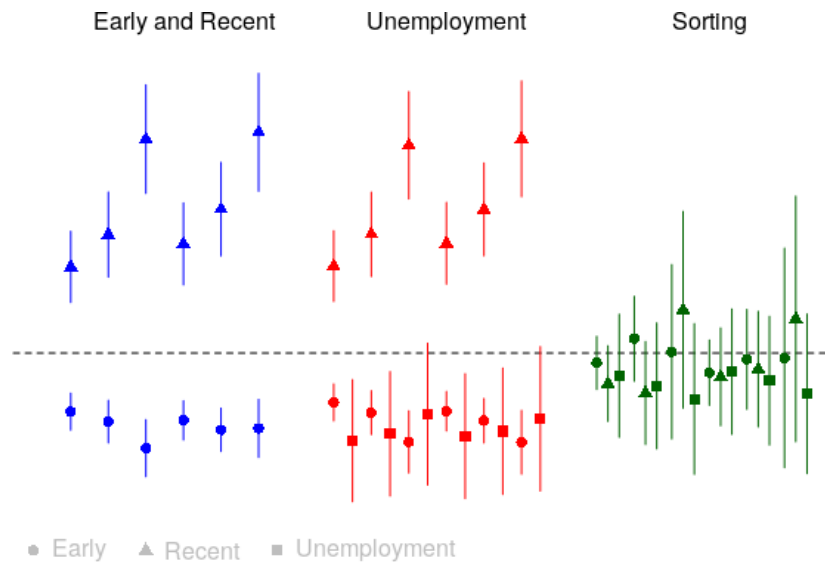
Perceptions of competition matter



Alternative: sorting on job indicators



Results are robust to self-selection



Apparent labour-force competition

Attitudes reflect competition at the occupational level



Sorting on job indicators makes labour-force competition 'disappear'
